

Registry Caregivers Needed

Do you have time in your schedule to provide care for those who have no one to care for them?

When a Recipient on IHSS is unable to find their own provider, they often ask their social worker for a recommendation. The IHSS Registry is a list screened and trained Providers willing to work for these Recipients.

Job Duties:	Caregivers assist the elderly and dependent adults, with personal care, household chores and other tasks such as: Bathing, Dressing, Grooming, Feeding, Cooking, Shopping, Laundry and Doctor Appointments
Requirements:	Completion of a background check and attendance at Caregiver training class is required before we can refer you to our Recipients.
Other Information:	Caregivers are paid \$12.00 per hour. During the application process, you can specify the cities you would like to work in, and the amount of hours you are available to work. The hours are flexible, and you can arrange your own schedule with your IHSS clients. If you currently live in the Oakdale, Patterson or Newman areas, we have work for you.
